Proverbs 23:12 "Instructions"

Chaplain's Corner

December 2024 – January 2025

If you are working with the wrong information, you are going to end up with disastrous results. Always. This is why Proverbs encourages us to "apply our heart to instruction and our ears to words of knowledge" God's wisdom (v.12). If we instead seek advice from those who are foolish, those who pretend to know more than they do and who have turned their back on God, we'll be in trouble. They "scorn.... prudent words" (v.9) and can lead us astray with unhelpful, misguided, or even deceptive advice. Instead, we can bend our "ears to words of knowledge" (v.12). We can open our heart and receive God's liberating instruction, words of clarity and hope. When we listen to those who know the deep ways of God, they help us receive and follow divine wisdom. And God's wisdom will never lead us astray but always encourages and leads us toward life and wholeness. At life's crossroads, how do you make decisions? Sometimes it is helpful to recognize and write down your spiritual landmarks – the places in your journey God has guided and directed you powerfully. By creating a kind of spiritual map or story, you can remember how God communicates, moves, and speaks to you personally, helping you to discern his voice in your current situation. But he often works in new ways – so be ready for surprises too!

Lord God, thank you for allowing us to listen to your instruction, hear your discipline and mature into the people we were created to be... that we can open-heartedly confront our mistakes and humbly learn from them. Amen.

Our prayers and sympathies go to the families of our dearly departed sisters and brothers that have passed and haven't been reported yet or that I apologetically may have missed in these last two months. This is the first since I've been your Chaplain Officer since 06/2018!
